BECOME A JUNIOR COMMISSIONED OFFICER
(RELIGIOUS TEACHER) JCO (RT) COURSES 80, 81 & 82



1. Applications are invited from eligible male candidates for recruitment of Religious Teachers in Indian Army as Junior Commissioned Officer for RRT 80, 81 & 82 courses. Religious Teachers preach religious scriptures to troops and conduct various rituals at Regimental/Unit religious institutions. Their duties also include attending funerals, ministering to the sick in hospitals, reading prayers with the convalescents, visiting soldiers undergoing sentence, giving special religious instructions to the children and enlisted boys besides attending generally to the religious institutions and welfare of the Officers, Soldiers and their families.

(f) The list of finally selected candidates will be displayed at their respective HQ Recruiting Zones by **04 May 2016**. Recruiting organization will not be responsible for non receipt of communication due to postal errors and incorrect/incomplete address furnished by the candidates.

(g) Candidates finally selected will be enrolled as JCO (RT) and will undergo six weeks training at Regimental Centre followed by eleven week training at Institute of National Integration, Pune.

(h) Rejection can take place at any stage during training also.

8. TERMS OF SERVICE

(a) **Appointment.** On successful completion of training the candidates will be commissioned as Religious Teachers in the rank of Naib Subedar.

(b) **Promotion.** All JCOs (Religious Teachers) will become eligible for substantive rank of Subedar/Risaldar on completion of at least 10 years service as religious teachers.

(c) **Pay, Allowances and Perks.** The JCO (RT) will be placed at the minimum pay scale of Rs. 9300-34800. In addition they will be entitled to DA, free accommodation, entitled ration for self, uniform, free medical and leave travel concession for self, family, and dependents, canteen facilities and other allowances as admissible to the regular Army.

(d) **Retirement.** Normal age of superannuation for JCO (RT) in the rank of Subedar will be 57 years. A Subedar Major (RT) will retire on completion of 4 years of service as Subedar Major or 57 years of age, whichever is earlier.

HOW TO APPLY

(a) The recruitment will be carried out through all the Headquarters Recruiting Zones, Independent Recruiting Office, Delhi Cantt, Ladakh Scout Regimental Centre, Leh, Gorkha Recruiting Depot, Kunraghat and 11 Gorkha Rifle Regimental Centre, Lucknow.

(b) Candidates must apply to the concerned HQ Rtg Zone/IRO Delhi Cantt/ of which the individual is a permanent native/resident.

(c) Candidates can appear for written exam only for the place of domicile.

(d) Application submitted to a different organization of which the candidate is not domicile of will be rejected.

(e) Submission of Application

(i) **ONLINE APPLICATION.** For candidates applying for **Pandit, Granthi and Padre** categories, applications will only be accepted online on website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. [Detailed instructions given in 'INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE APPLICATION']

(ii) **Muslim (Shia) candidates of Ladakh region** applying for Maulvi (Shia) category will submit written application duly filled to Ladakh Scouts Regimental Centre only. [Please refer application proforma]

(iii) **Gorkha Candidates applying for Pandit (Gorkha)** category will submit written application duly filled to Gorkha Recruiting Depot Kunraghat only. [Please refer application proforma]

(iv) **Budhist (Mahayana) candidates of Sikkim Region only** will submit written application duly filled to 11 Gorkha Rifle Regimental Centre, Lucknow only. [Please refer application proforma]

(v) **Budhist (Mahayana) candidates of Other than Sikkim** will submit written application duly filled to Ladakh Scouts Regimental Centre only. [Please refer application proforma]

(vi) Postal Addresses of all Headquarters Recruiting Zones & concerned Regimental Centres are given at **Para 10**

NOTE

(f) All above terms and conditions, vacancies and selection procedures are subject to change from time to time.

(g) List of recognised universities to be verified from nearest HQ Recruiting Zone / Army Recruiting Office/ Independent Recruiting Office, Delhi Cantt.

(h) Only male candidates are eligible to apply.

(i) Candidates who are serving with any organization and are selected for the interview will produce "No Objection Certificate" from their employer at Zonal Recruiting Office before dispatch.

(k) Touts and agents have no role to play and candidates are advised not to be lured by such agents/agencies.

(l) The candidates are required to produce the following documents, when called for screening :-

(i) Character certificate by Sarpanch of the Village or authorized signatory of the State Government.

(ii) Domicile/Resident/Nativity certificate from the authorized signatory of the state Government.

(iii) Original Certificate from matriculation onward and detailed Mark sheet of each year separately pertaining to Educational qualification.

(iv) NCC Certificate in original, if applicable.

(v) Son of serviceman/Ex-servicemen, son of war widow/son of widow, certificate in original, if applicable.

(m) Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e., from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal)side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection. Tribes with tattoo marks on the face or body as per their existing custom and traditions will be permitted on a case to case basis.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE APPLICATION : JCO (RT) PANDIT, GRANTHI AND PADRE CATEGORIES

HOW TO APPLY ONLINE

1. Recruitment of Junior Commissioned Officer (Religious Teacher) for Pandit, Granthi and Padre categories will be through the online registration and online application on our website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in.

2. Candidates can "check their eligibility" on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in and can apply online for chosen / eligible career option in the Indian Army. For online application candidates should carry the following:-

- (a) Education qualification certificates including matriculation certificate.
- (b) Personal details, including permanent address with PIN Number.
- (c) Verification / domicile certificate.
- (d) Have a personal valid e-mail.
- (e) Have a personal mobile number.

3. Online registration and application will remain open from **01 Dec 2015 at 1000 hrs to 31 Dec 2015 at 1700 hrs**. Rally schedules (Preliminary screening) will be notified on the website.

4. **Procedure for Applying Online.** For registering online, visit the website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in and proceed as follow:-

(a) Click on the portion 'Apply Online' on the home page in JCO/ OR enrolment row (green coloured).

(b) Fill the online registration form. Tips to assist in filling up field have been provided as you highlight each field.

(c) After filling the details, Your profile will open.

(d) Click on Apply Online. As per your eligibility, the options with caption Apply Online will appear. Click on the Button to apply and details filled in during registration will come as pre-filled. Fill the balance details on each tab like contact details and education details.

(e) After filling the form, click on preview and check if all the information entered by you is correct as you will not be able to make any correction after saving.

(f) On submitting you will receive a Roll Number.

(g) Candidates can log in by using the e-mail id and password and can take the print out of the Application form.

(h) Once the registration closes on the last day, system will generate Admit Cards for eligible candidates.

(j) Applicants are advised to check the profile on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in and their e-mail inbox for their Admit Card and alerts.

(k) The candidates are required to print one copy of Admit Card and affix their recent passport size photograph on it.

NOTE

(i) Online registration does not imply that the candidate has fulfilled all the criteria for recruitment.

(ii) Your registration is subject to subsequent scrutiny and can be rejected, if found INELIGIBLE/INVALID at any point of time.

(iii) Please print Admit Card on good quality paper in black and white mode with min 600 x 600 dpi or higher resolution.

(iv) Admit Card is compulsory document to be carried for rally on scheduled date alongwith following documents :-

(aa) Photocopy of character certificate by Sarpanch of the Village or authorized signatory of the State Government.

(ab) Photocopy Domicile/Resident/Nativity certificate from the authorized signatory of the state Government.

(ac) Photocopy Certificate from matriculation onward and detailed Mark sheet of each year separately pertaining to Educational qualification.

(ad) Photocopy of NCC Certificate, if applicable.

(ae) Photocopy of relationship certificate issued by concerned Record Officer for Son of serviceman/Ex-servicemen, son of war widow, if applicable.
